Host Organization Grant Guidelines

Overview

The objective of ACF's Ted Smith Conservation Internship Program is to match highly qualified interns with host organizations, providing interns with practical job skills and an introduction to conservation in Alaska while also supporting the organization in meeting its conservation goals. Selected organizations receive a grant from ACF to cover the cost of an intern stipend for 12 weeks (\$5,040).

Eligibility

Successful applicants will meet the following criteria:

- 501c3 nonprofit organization in Alaska
- Have a mission related to Alaska conservation; preference will be given to applicants that focus on salmon preservation, citizen participation, and climate change and energy solutions
- Preference will be given to applicants who aim to meaningfully engage the intern in the organization's work
- If a prior ACF grantee, must be in good standing
