



Alpenglow Grant Program Guidelines

Overview:

Alaska Conservation Foundation supports direct conservation work that protects Alaska's unique landscapes and ways of life by supporting conservation leaders, organizations, and initiatives.

The Alpenglow Grant Program provides grant awards to Alaska-based grassroots organizations in order to foster a more effective Alaska conservation movement through funding opportunities that strengthen the movement's leadership base, encourage collaboration, and help leaders, organizations, and Tribes navigate changing political and economic climates.

Grant awards range from \$500 to \$2,000.

Applications will be reviewed and evaluated on a rolling basis.

Eligibility:

- Non-profit organizations in Alaska, or with an Alaska-based program
- 501c3, 501c4, 501c6 and federally recognized tribes are eligible to apply
- If a current ACF grantee, must be in good standing with grant reporting

Grant Awards will support:

Strategic opportunities that strengthen the movement's leadership base, encourage collaboration, and help leaders and organizations navigate changing political and economic climates. Supported activities may include:

- Training for staff and board
- Meeting facilitation
- Legal assistance
- Travel
- Conference fees
- Outreach and Advocacy
- Strategic program expansion
- Up to 15% Administrative Fee

The following are not eligible:

- Operating expenses, including staff salaries (beyond the 15% administrative fee)
- Equipment, land acquisition, research
- Ongoing program expenses
- Education programs or scholarships
- Capital campaigns
- For-profit organizations
- Individuals
